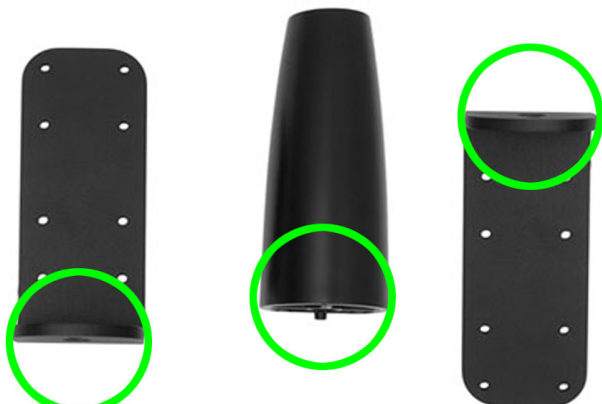

STEP 1 OF 8

Arm Base:

The articulating arm can be mounted to the L-bracket top or bottom depending on the preferred location and position of the mount itself. Use the included fastener to secure the arm to the L-bracket.

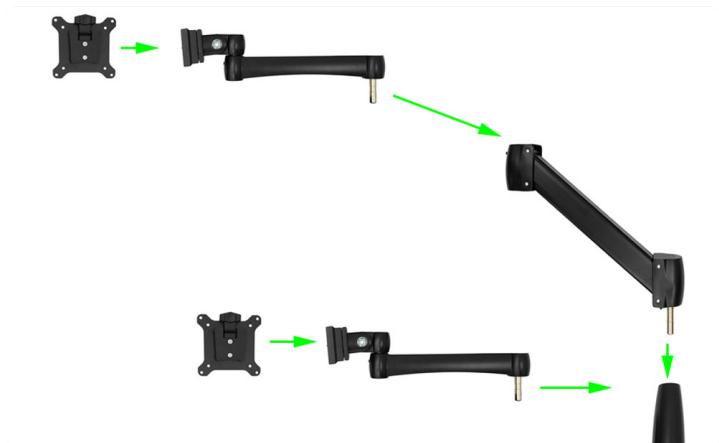


STEP 2 OF 8

Install in Wood, Concrete or Metal

Due to the overall weight of this articulating arm and attached items on the end, it is recommended to be installed directly into solid wood, a concrete wall with appropriate sealant (not included) or a metal wall.

Warning: Installing into only sheetrock or drywall will likely loosen over time and cause the mount to pull out of the wall.



STEP 3 OF 8

Arm Assembly:

This articulating arm has two joints that can be used together, or without the middle tension spring section. The pin on the end of each section secures into the matching hole for a connection that provides free motion for each joint section.



STEP 4 OF 8

Tension Setting

One arm features a tension spring to adjust the force used to support the attached item. To adjust the force of this spring, use the included Allen wrench to tighten or loosen the tension on the spring to allow the arm to rest at the desired height.



STEP 5 OF 8

Attach Pipe Mounts:

Using the included fasteners, attach the pipe clamp to the pair of AMPS patterns on the L-Bracket. This allows the arm base to be secured to a pipe or bar.



STEP 6 OF 8

Remove Bolts:

With the hex wrench (provided) unscrew and remove the two hex bolts. Then separate the two sections of the Pipe Mount.



STEP 7 OF 8

Fit Rubber Strip:

Place the rubber strip around the section of the pipe where you would like to attach the Pipe Mount.



STEP 8 OF 8

Secure Pipe Mount:

Place the two sections of the Pipe Mount into position around the pipe where the rubber strip is located. Put the hex bolts back into place and tighten them with the hex wrench.
