STEP 1 OF 8

Mounting the Cradle:

This cradle features the AMPS and VESA75 hole pattern in the steel base plate. AMPS is common for many ball and vehicle mounts and VESA75 is common in telecommunications and office environments.

The Included M4 Fastener pack provides several lengths of fastener, two types of washer and lock nuts to ensure a good fit to your chosen mount.



STEP 2 OF 8

Recommended Installation tools

The included hub and cover can make the installation of a pedestal base more difficult. It is recommended that you use a 7mm wrench to hold the lock nut in place. when attaching with the included fasteners.



STEP 3 OF 8

Docking:

Place the lower part of the device in the cradle and align the tablet to the grooved side walls. This tablet features a softer rubber side, so it is important to dock it accurately.



STEP 4 OF 8

Docking Continued:

Slide the device down onto the USB-C connector ensuring that the tablet slides all the way down onto the connector and to the bottom of the channeled side walls.



STEP 5 OF 8

Swiveling Top Lock:

To ensure the tablet is secured in the dock, slide the top swivel over the top edge of the tablet. The swivel has a key lock to ensure the tablet cannot be removed without the appropriate key. The key lock can be set in 3 positions.

To lock the tablet in place, press the center pin of the lock down.



STEP 6 OF 8

Unlocking:

Turn the key until the center pin pops out and slide the lock up.



STEP 7 OF 8

Swivel:

Turn the swivel top until it clears the tablet.



STEP 8 OF 8

Undocking:

Lift the tablet up and out of the cradle until it is clear of the sidewalls.
